RAJA AMPAT

With limestone islands, sandy beaches and hidden coves, dense mangrove forests, steep cliffs and lush reefs in the open sea, an incredible variety awaits all visitors above and below the water. Raja Ampat offers one of the richest marine environments in the world, and the small number of visitors makes for individual diving at places that are rarely dived by others. Discover one of nature's last reserves!

DIVING IN RAJA AMPAT

Apart from colorful and healthy reefs, Raja Ampat also offers an enormous abundance of fish. Big schools of barracudas, shoals of small reef fish and batfish, as well as bigeye mackerels, bumphead parrotfish and fusiliers, preyed upon by Spanish mackerels, are often found in the same spot. Macro lovers will enjoy countless species of nudibranchs, crabs and shrimps, as well as various pygmy seahorses, to mention just a few.

RESORT

The dive resort Raja4Divers opened in June 2011 on Pulau (island) Pef and is under Swiss management. It is built in the authentic Papuan style and offers exclusivity as well as great comfort, while still nurturing an informal and homely atmosphere. Ten spacious over-water bungalows, with large semi-open bathrooms and a big sun-set deck offer plenty of space for leisure and relaxation. Enjoy Raja Ampat's incredible sunsets right in front of your bungalow!

PULAU PEF

Thanks to its diversity, Pulau Pef is a very unique island. Besides the easily accessible house reef, it features coconut fringed beaches, spectacular bays and lagoons, a hidden lake, rocky outcrops, limestone 'mushroom' islands with unexplored caves, mangrove and rain forests, wild orchids, ancient rock art and a unique wildlife. Diving

In addition to unlimited house reef diving we offer three daily trips to different dive sites. We have 11 liter aluminium tanks (DIN/INT adapter) available. Our modern speedboats offer space for 8 divers and are all equipped with a DAN Oxygen and emergency set.
