If you're lucky you might meet wales, dolphins or even a sunfish or sailfish on the way to Pulau Pef!



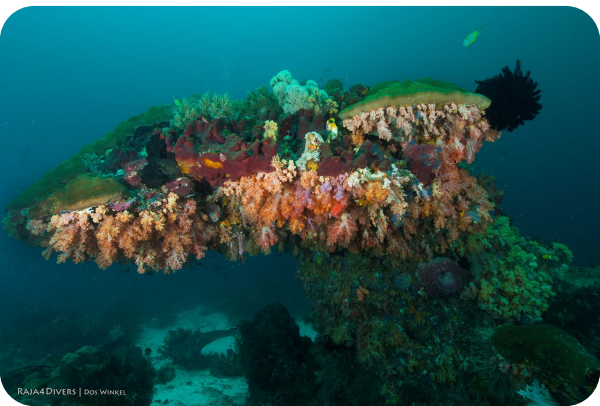


And another highlight:

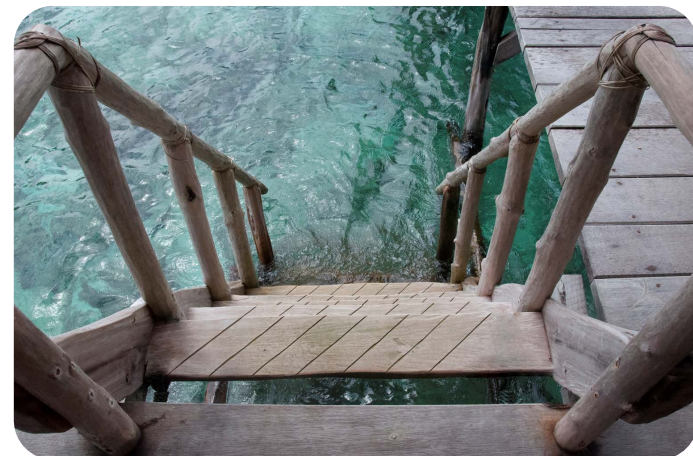


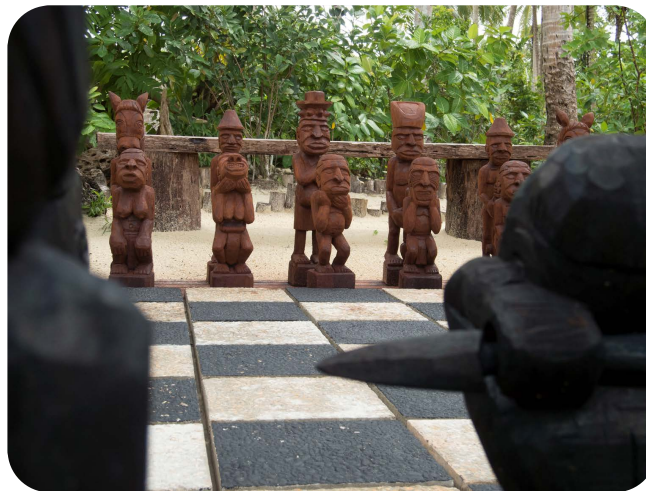
Staying at Pulau Pef you will discover each day more and more details over the whole resort.
