AKU PAPUA - I'M A PAPUAN!

Being a Papuan resort, we are proud to collaborate with the local people of our area:

50% of our employees are Papuans that we sometimes train from scratch. Some of them have been working for us for many years already. We buy fruit, vegetables, chilis, herbs and coconut oil from the families of our neighboring village Kabui and fresh fish that local fishermen bring us every day, as well as wood, roof mats and other building material from villages surrounding us.

This allows us to support the people of our area and avoid long transports whenever possible for food and building material.

The compulsory Marine Park Tag, valid for one year, now only costs IDR 700'000 (approx. € 50) instead of IDR 1'000'000 (approx. € 70).
